John was a New Zealand artist and farmer who lived most of his life on a farm near Wellsford. He also spent several years living in Mangawhai Heads.

An artist for over 30 years, John was a prolific painter and printmaker. During his lifetime he created 15 large murals, several hundred small paintings and many prints. He had over 50 exhibitions of his work at commercial and public art galleries, and his murals were featured on television several times.
